Black Friday Re-Enrollment 2025-2026 School Year Sale

Re-enrollment for the 2025-2026 school year for all *current* SOTI students begins on Friday, November 29th. This year we are excited to offer our very own Black Friday Sale, which also includes a chance to win a tuition credit prize! The link to the active 2025-2026 re-enrollment portal will be sent the morning of Black Friday.

Complete the intent to re-enroll form and payment between 8:00 AM on Black Friday, November 29, 2024 and midnight on Cyber Monday, December 3, 2024 and pay the discounted fee of \$100 per student. Student accounts with the intent to re-enroll form and payment completed during the sale period will be entered into a drawing, and the winner will be awarded a \$2,500 tuition credit for the 2025-2026 school year*.

The regular re-enrollment fee schedule for the 2025-2026 school year is

- \$115/student if paid between December 3rd and January 10th.
- \$175/student if paid between January 11th and January 31st
- \$250/student if paid between February 1st and February 14th
- If not paid by February 14th, your child's spot will be released.

*The tuition credit is non-transferable and is a credit for the 2025-2026 tuition only. This is not a cash voucher.

Students applying for grades 1-8, can get an admissions decision prior to Christmas following the early action timeline below.



New Family Referral Program



Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family <u>after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.</u>
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
