## **SOTI Summer Camp 2025 Dates and Themes**

We are so happy to share information about this year's summer camps! In addition to the traditional **Summer Knights Camps (Gr. K-4)**, we will continue to offer 5 weeks of **Summer Social Camps for students in grades 5-8!** **All grade levels refer to the 2025-2026 school year.**

Below is information for all programs, and a calendar for the scheduled camps.

Each **Summer Knights Camp** lasts one week and is independent of the other weeks. Families can choose the weeks that work best for them. These camps consist of age appropriate activities and in house field trips which follow the theme for the week. There may be the opportunity for off campus field trips as well (TBD). Off site field trips will have additional field trip fees of no more than \$30.00 per trip.

Each **Summer Social Camp** lasts one week and is independent of the other weeks. Families can choose the weeks that work best for them. There are two weeks in June and three in July. These camps will consist of age appropriate activities and games to allow the students to spend time with their peers having fun while being active indoors and out. This also includes short day trips for activities such as minigolf, bowling and movies. \*Special note for 5th grade parents. Fifth grade students participating in summer camps, will spend the morning in the older group (Summer Social Camps). You may choose to have them leave at 12:15 PM with the students in grades 6-8. If you wish for your 5th grader to remain for the full day, they would transition to the Summer Knight Camp from 12:15-4:00 PM.

### UPDATES

Arts and Crafts Club: Preschool and Kindergarten members have been having fun with such activities as painting and decorating picture frames, making penguins and polar bears, and creating snowflake themed projects like the salt art one in which eyedroppers were used to watch how water colors spread.

SOTI Scientists Club: Members have explored rocks using magnifying glasses to determine similarities and differences, learned about electrical circuits and then created them using "Little Bits" kits, compared different types of animal fur, saw a moving model of the Solar System to learn about the order of the planets, and practiced their observation skills.

The Creation and Imagination Club: Some of the fun that students in this club have enjoyed include making salt art pictures, snow themed bracelets, and using toothpicks with gummy hearts to make buildings, windmills, and flowers.

Dance and Cheer Squad members continue doing a wonderful job learning their dance routine as well as several cheers! They start each meeting with stretches and practicing different skills. They're hoping to cheer at one of the final upcoming home basketball games and then plan to perform at the Faculty vs. 8th grade game in March.

Knights Chess Club members continue to develop their skills learning and practicing the basics of the game. Some enjoy the variety of playing against each other as well as on the Chromebook against a "robot" who helps suggest possible moves to try.

The three Lego Explore Teams are finalizing their projects and presentations for this season. The 2nd grade team will present to family members next week and the other two teams will participate in a "Festival" on February 22nd at Johns Hopkins, APL.

Thank you for being on time, parking in the lot, and walking to the sidewalk to let the volunteers and/or Miss Santini know that you're taking your child. # New Family Referral Program

Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
